ABOUT THE FORUM

Stolypin Forum — is a modern international platform, which unites Russian and foreign experts, heads and ex-heads of state authorities and institutions for development, representatives of the business community and the mass media; it is also a broad forum for entrepreneurs.

Every year the Forum creates an opportunity for state representatives, and Russian and international experts and entrepreneurs to discuss the main decision for the country – the path for further socio-economic development:

- **To create a single image** of the economic strategy and program of economic reforms among the population, the expert community, and business and government.
- **To emphasize the general strategic goal** of the reforms: economic growth at a rate not lower than the global average through the development of new sources of economic growth and the growth of the standard and quality of life of our citizens.
- **To create a system for managing strategic development and reforms.**

The event is organized by the Stolypin Institute for the Economy of Growth and “Moscow State University for International Relations (MGIMO)” with the support of Corporation “Rostec”.

The forum was held twice (2018 and 2019) at MGIMO.

The first day of the forum will be devoted to the main tools of macroeconomic policy aimed at improving the sustainability and recovery of economies of countries and the global economy as a whole. Within the framework of this key discussion, experts will present various models for strengthening the immunity of economies in the post-coronavirus world.

The topic of the second day of the forum is the discussion of international experience in improving the competitiveness of goods and services by means of the digital transformation of industries in the context of COVID-19. The participants will present the main tools and technologies used in the digital transformation of commercial and non-profit sectors. The key discussion of the day will be devoted to the experience of the digital transformation of public administration and the protection of citizens' rights.

Representatives of countries, including **Germany, the United Kingdom, France, Sweden, Finland, Norway, the Netherlands, Italy, the Czech Republic, Israel, the United Arab Emirates, and Qatar**, will present their experiences in strengthening the immune system of industries and economies.

The forum will bring together representatives of the authorities of the Russian Federation and other countries, experts, representatives of leading Russian and foreign companies and a new generation of Russian entrepreneurs who implement their bold ideas, believing in opportunities to develop their own business in Russia.

The total number of participants and speakers will be up to 45,000 online participants or viewers of live broadcasts from the forum site, 1,000 online participants with an opportunity to participate in discussions and up to 1,000 offline participants, speakers and staff for 2 days.

CHAIRMAN OF THE GOVERNMENT, 1905-1911

"If the outlined trends continue up to 1950, Russia will dominate in Europe in politics, economics and finances."

Edmond Teri,
French economist,
sent by the French government to study the Russian economy in 1912

His reforms:

- fostering the mentality of private owners, developing private initiative and competition
- agrarian reform
- local self-government reform
- the reform of courts

Their results by 1913:

- Global leadership in grain production and export
- A positive surplus of the budget and the trade balance
- An increase in industrial production by more than 8% annually
- Public education expenditures increased by 256%
- Defense expenditures increased by 50.1%
- Russia's population grew by 32 million, or 22.7%
